Each accreditation body should interpret the new requirements exactly as written. Experience, however, indicates that this may not always be the case. The good news is that any deviations in interpretation from the specification given in the standard will be relatively minor, until ILAC (or other authoritative body) provides the accreditation bodies with a common interpretation.
