MTERNATIONAL ACCEPTATION Independence and Impartiality

Impartiality is the concept that decisions made with regard to something are **based solely on the defined merits or** <u>criteria related to it,</u> or its operation, or some other aspect of its being. That is to say, only those things can be used in the decision – nothing else, and certainly nothing related to the decision maker.

Independence and Impartiality	
Conflict of interest is the concept that something other than those defined merits or criteria are influencing the decisions related to that thing. People or organizations are deemed to	
be in conflict of interest when they are associated with any condition or organization that might have an interest in	
influencing the outcome of the decisions.	
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Independence and Impartiality	
Simple conflict interest can be deemed to exist whenever	
more than one relationship connects two parties. When this occurs, it is not possible to ensure that one relationship is not	
being influence by the dynamics of the other.
