ISO/IEC 17020 Inspection Processes

1. There are 7 questions.
2. Participants have 20 seconds to read each question.
3. When asked, they must select and record their own answers.
4. The whole group is balloted for the correct response.
5. Clapping indicates a correctly answered question. Buzzer indicates an incorrectly answered question.
6. The quiz then advances to the next question.
7. When the quiz is complete, participants score their own answers (percentage) and compare with the self evaluation.
