Dear Madam or Sir:

Proposed Revisions to the Accreditation Criteria for Inspection Agencies (AC98) have been placed on the agenda for committee consideration at the above-noted meeting.

Proposed changes include:

- 1. Line 36 and Line 60: Added ILAC P10 *ILAC Policy on Metrological Traceability of Measurement Results* as normative and accreditation criteria document, which is ILAC compulsory policy document for inspection agency accreditation.
- 2. Lines 37-38: Added ILAC P9 *ILAC Policy for Proficiency Testing and/or Interlaboratory comparisons other than Proficiency Testing* as normative document, which is ILAC compulsory policy document for inspection agency accreditation.
- 3. Lines 39-441: Added ILAC P8 *ILAC Mutual Recognition Arrangement* (Arrangement): Supplementary Requirements for the Use of Accreditation Symbols and for Claims of Accreditation Status by Accredited Conformity Assessment Bodies as normative reference which is ILAC compulsory policy document for inspection agency accreditation.
- 4. Line 42: Added ILAC R7 *Rules for the Use of the ILAC MRA Mark* as normative document, which is compulsory document for all ILAC MRA signatories.
- 5. Line 44: Added ILAC G27 *Guidance on measurements performed as part of an inspection process* as reference document to harmonize the interpretation of measurements involved in the inspection.
- 6. Lines 45-46: Added ILAC G28 *Guideline for the Formulation of Scopes of Accreditation for Inspection Bodies* as reference document to harmonize the accreditation scope.

- 7. Lines 61-62: Added IAS/ADM/103 *IAS Policy on Participation in Proficiency Testing and/or Interlaboratory Comparisons* as accreditation criteria, which addresses the requirements of ILAC P10.
- 8. Line 63: Added IAS/ADM/084 *Policy on the use of the ILAC/IAF/IAS Combined Marks* as accreditation criteria, which addresses the requirements of ILAC P8.

You are cordially invited to submit written comments, or to attend the WebEx committee hearing and present verbal comments. Written comments will be forwarded to the committee, **prior to the hearing**, if received by **May 30, 2025**. For your convenience, a comment form is provided. Parties interested in proposed revised criteria may deliver written communications and submissions regarding such proposed criteria to IAS within approximately 30 days of posting of the public notice on the IAS website. The committee shall be informed of all pertinent written communications received by IAS. Any relevant communication and changes to a criteria arising from the written communication/submission shall be posted to the IAS website prior to the meeting.

Participants at the accreditation committee meetings shall have the opportunity to speak on the proposed criteria to provide information to the committee. Committee meetings are generally held by electronic means. Participants are responsible to ensure access to appropriate computer equipment, software, and internet connectivity to ensure effective participation during the meeting.

Your cooperation is requested in forwarding to IAS, as noted above, all material directed to the committee. Prior to the hearing, parties interested in the deliberations of the committee should refrain from communicating, whether in writing or verbally, with committee members regarding agenda items. The committee reserves the right to refuse communications that do not comply with this request.
